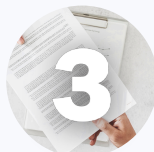

Learn if you have EPR obligations in Spain:

→ Authorization:

Non-resident product producers, foreign importers, e-commerce sellers, and specific packaging businesses without a registered office in Spain must designate an authorized representative in Spain to comply with local regulations regarding packaging, waste electrical equipment, batteries, and EPRS obligations.



→ Packaging EPRS:

All companies selling or delivering packaged goods to consumers in Spain must register in the Packaging EPRS. This includes non-resident product producers, foreign importers, e-commerce sellers, and businesses in specific packaging sectors.



→ Waste electrical equipment EPRS:

Companies manufacturing, importing, or distributing appliances that are classified as EEE, for consumers in Spain must be registered in the WEEE EPRS. This requirement applies to all companies placing these products on the Spanish market.



→ Battery EPRS:

All companies introducing batteries or devices with batteries to the Spanish market, including manufacturers, distributors, and online retailers, must register in Spain's batteries EPRS.
